This has been a very busy and exciting week at All Saints'.

Our Roald Dahl Day was a great success! It was wonderful to see the children dressed as their favourite book character and to hear them talk about their favourite Roald Dahl book. PARKING

We have received a number of complaints from local residents about cars being parked across driveways, on the grass at Hall Mead and on the bend by Lawshall Hall. 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We are still awaiting the construction of a pavement along the road by The Swan but there have been some planning issues, which are currently in the process of being resolved. Once this pavement is in place, parents will be able to park along the pavement by Swanfield and walk safely to school. This will undoubtedly alleviate many of our parking issues but in the meantime we ask that parents park safely and with consideration of local residents.
