Welcome back! I hope you all had a wonderful summer. I am looking forward to welcoming all of you to Horse Chestnut class and getting to know you all.

Behaviour and Rewards

In Horse Chestnut class this term we will be trialling the good to be green behaviour system. This will run alongside the children working hard to earn tickets for a draw at the end of the week. All children will begin every lesson with a green card. If they are not following our class rules, they will be given a verbal warning. If they continue this behaviour, the card will be replaced with an amber warning card. If the child persists with the behaviour they will be given a red card, meaning they will miss 5 minutes of their break. On the other hand, golden cards will be awarded to children constantly trying their best.

Reading Challenge

I will also be trialling a reading challenge in the class, whereby the children will receive a certificate every twenty-five times they are heard by an adult read. Whenever you hear your child read, make sure you make a note of this in their reading logs and every time an adult has signed the reading log for twenty-five reads, the children will receive a certificate.

Homework

As well as daily reading, the children will receive homework every Tuesday, which will be due in the following Monday. This will commence on Tuesday 11th September. Your child will also come home with a times table to practise for the weekly times table test on a Tuesday and they will receive a set of spellings, which will be tested on Thursday.

Lawshall Mile

This year, All Saints' have decided to take part in a new initiative to get all the children more active and boost energy levels throughout the school day.

Our aim is that throughout the week, the children will achieve walking a mile combined throughout the week.

Horse Chestnut class will be completing this after lunch on a Monday and Wednesday.
