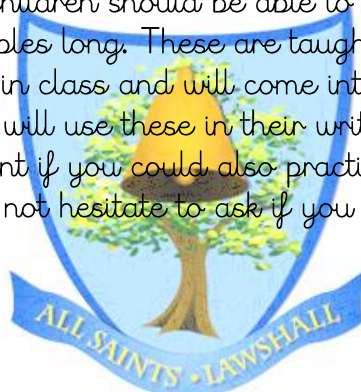


## Two or more syllable words
