## INTERNET SAFETY

I have had a number of responses to my emails regarding the Momo Challenge and internet safety. It would seem that a number of children were already aware of the Momo Challenge from their own experience or from hearing from children both in and out of school about their own experiences of seeing messages, particularly those with older siblings. Please could I urge all parents to check your internet security settings, monitor carefully the sites that your child is accessing and to talk to your child about things they may have seen or be worried about online. It may be that your child has seen something but is too afraid to tell you in case they get someone else into trouble or the threat that something may happen to their family if they do as this is often a feature of Momo and other similar online apps.

As a school we have robust filters and security procedures that stop children accessing social media sites but we are aware that a growing number of young children have their own laptops, iphones and tablets and can access sites that are not appropriate or safe. We are currently trying to set up a parental session with an internet safety expert regarding online safety and how you can protect your child online. I will let you know when we have set up a date for this and we would urge as many of you to attend as possible.
