The purpose of the session was to look at ways in which to address concerns raised at the last SEND Parent Forum regarding developing morning routines, supporting independence and helping children to regulate their feelings.

Julia shared a range of resources and strategies that parents could implement at home. These included visual resources to support developing daily routines, creating social stories, co-writing comic strip conversations and strategies to help children and parents to regulate emotions.
