Parent Survey Results – Summer Term 2019

Dear Parents/Guardians

A big thank you to everyone who took the time to complete our parent survey. We had 64 responses which is fantastic for a school of our size and shows us how much everyone feels engaged with their children's education at All Saints'.

Even though our school is outstanding, we are constantly reviewing our practice and developing new approaches to ensuring that what we can offer your children is as good as it can be. This is one reason why we place so much value on the responses to questionnaires like this as it provides key insights into how effective any changes have been.

A new introduction this year was the opportunity for you to provide some feedback about how individual staff have helped your children this year. There really were some amazingly positive and moving responses which were split very evenly amongst year groups. All of these comments have been passed on and provide a much needed boost as we run up to the end of the school year.

A major theme that came through from this year's survey is how positive you feel about the competence and commitment of all staff at All Saints'. This is particularly heartening for us as it is the most important factor in delivering an outstanding education. We expect a huge amount from our staff and invest significant resources to help them continue to grow and develop as educators. It's good to know that parents are seeing the results.

Again, there are some lovely comments about how caring, friendly and happy the school is, how there is a real sense of community and that staff are open and approachable. There is also a big increase in the percentage of you that feel very positive about leadership, dealing with concerns, the wide range of extra-curricular opportunities children have and how well the school communicates with you.

This year, it is hard to pull out themes from the question that asks about what we could do better as the responses are more about specific individual issues. The only one that is mentioned several times is about parking and the pavement outside school. Although this is an area outside of the school's control, we do regularly chase the Local Authority for updates. We recognise that progress with the footpath extension towards the pub has been painfully slow but are pleased to report that the last landowner has now signed the legal documents necessary for the project to move forwards. Hopefully we will see evidence of this in the coming months.
