ILLNESS WITHIN SCHOOL

Last week we had a number of children who were unwell with a stomach upset, vomiting or both. Please could we remind parents that children should only return to school 48 hours after their last bout of sickness or upset stomach in order to stop it spreading to other children.

We do have a number of children in school with a cold. However, if children present with a cough or temperature we will ask parents to take their child for a PCR test. We understand that this can be inconvenient and frustrating for parents but the national and local picture shows a rise in numbers of children with Covid and 1200 of these cases have been in Suffolk schools in the past fortnight. We are following the safety guidance and procedures issued by the DfE and this week our air purifiers will be in place but we need to ensure that children presenting with symptoms are tested in order to ensure that we do not have an outbreak within school.
