Even though our school is outstanding, we are constantly reviewing our practice and developing new approaches to ensure that we can offer the best quality education and support for every child at All Saints'. This is one reason why we place so much value on the responses to surveys like this as it enables us to know what you value and what is working well for your child.

The major themes that have come through from this year's survey are how positive you feel about the support and commitment of all staff at All Saints', our child-centered approach, the quality of education and our communication with our families. We are greatly heartened by such positive feedback as these are all key ingredients of the outstanding education that we pride ourselves on providing for our pupils.

It is hard to pull out themes from the survey question that asks about what we could do better as the responses are more about individual ideas. The only one that is mentioned several times is about expanding the range of clubs that we are able to offer. Mrs Plummer continues to do an amazing job coordinating the before and after school clubs and the addition of our musical theatre club this year has proved to be very popular. As a result of the pandemic and associated restrictions, we have needed to restrict some clubs to specific year groups and limit the number of clubs that we are able to offer. However, in the future, we will look forward to being able to expand and develop our club provision further across the school.
