FAMILY SHARE ACTIVITIES

Thank you to everyone who has been sending in donations to our family food share initiative, which has helped a number of families during these difficult times. Donations of food and toiletries can be brought into school at any time.

On Tuesday 15th November we will be holding our clothes and footwear sharing initiative. You can send in donations of unwanted school uniform and non-school clothes, including coats, Christmas jumpers and footwear in the morning. We will open up the school hall at 3pm so that you can pop in and take away any clothes that your child/ren will be able to use. None of the items will be priced and no payments will be expected, we want to hold an event that will support you as a family as well as be environmentally friendly by reusing unwanted items. If you wish to make a donation for any items there will be a donations box and any funds raised will be used to support our families.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

In the summer term, a working party of governors revised and updated our School Uniform Policy. One aspect of this policy focused on PE kit which is worn on the days that children have PE in school. Please could you ensure that children wear the school's PE uniform on these days and please note that football kits and sportswear (including sweatshirts and leggings) displaying motifs, wording and/ or logos are not permitted.

PE kit:

Pupils are expected to attend school wearing their PE kit on their timetabled PE day.

- Plain navy or school-branded navy t-shirt
- Plain navy or plain black shorts, skort, leggings or jogging bottoms
- Plain navy or school-branded jumper or fleece can be worn. Plain navy hooded sweatshirts are also permitted.
- Suitable sports trainers

Pupils attending out-of-hours sports clubs may wear non-uniform sportswear if they wish for these clubs.

DROPPING OFF AT THE START OF THE SCHOOL DAY

Yellow 'zig-zag' road markings outside schools are in place to ensure the safety of pupils. Please do not park or stop even for a short moment on these markings and please do not drop off your child within this area. Any cars stopped or parked in the restricted area can cause an obstruction and potential danger to other road users on this busy part of the road, including children who cycle to school.

Children in years 5 and 6 are able to come to school and go home unsupervised in consultation by parents with class teachers but all other children need to be supervised coming in and going home from school. The school gates do not open until 8.45am each day and children in all other year groups need to be supervised by parents until they come through the school gate.

DON'T FORGET....

The PTA will be holding an after-school bake sale on Tuesday 8th November. Donations of cakes and sweet treats are greatly appreciated and all funds raised will enable the PTA to support our forthcoming enrichment activities.

As the weather has now turned much colder (and wetter), please could you send your child to school in a warm coat along with gloves and hats. Please ensure that these are clearly labelled so that we can reunite children with any lost items.

Our sharing library will be open after school every Wednesday (from 3.20pm until 3.50pm) for children in EYFS and KS1. Please do come along with your child after school and choose one of our beautiful story books to take home and enjoy together.

We are very happy for children to bring a snack into school for morning break. Please ensure that these are healthy snacks such as fruit, vegetables, rice cakes, bread sticks and low sugar cereal bars.
