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Dear Parents,

A big thank you to everyone who took the time to complete our parent survey. We had 82 responses which is fantastic for a school of our size and shows us how much everyone feels engaged with their children's education at All Saints'.

Even though our school has been judged to be outstanding by OFSTED, we are constantly reviewing our practice and developing new approaches to ensure that we can offer the best quality education and support for every child at All Saints'. This is one reason why your responses to our annual survey are so important to us as they allow us to understand what you, as parents, value and feel is working well for your child.

The major themes that have come through from this year's survey are how positive you feel about the support and commitment of all staff at All Saints', our child-centred approach, the quality of education and our high expectations for every child at All Saints'. We are greatly heartened by such positive feedback as these are all key ingredients of the outstanding education that we pride ourselves on providing for our pupils.

It is hard to pull out themes from the survey feedback as the written feedback is more about individual ideas. The only one that is mentioned several times is about expanding the range of clubs that we are able to offer. Mrs Plummer continues to do an amazing job coordinating the before and after school clubs and the addition of our musical theatre club this year has proved to be very popular alongside our Go Wild Forest Schools Club. We also have our Woodpecker after-school club that offers a range of opportunities including arts and crafts activities.

We know that compared to other schools within our locality we offer a much wider range of clubs than other schools and this has been recognised as part of our Gold School Games quality mark accreditation year on year. As a small school, we do have limited space, which restricts the number of clubs that we are able to offer, particularly in the autumn and winter when the weather is unpredictable but we are always keen to expand our range of clubs where possible. We are keen to hear your views and if you have ideas for a before or an after-school club that we do not currently run and know someone who has the skills and experience to run this club then we would be very interested to look at finding a suitable space for this club alongside our existing club provision. My child is happy at this school

- The school creates such a welcoming and inclusive environment, which starts with the head teacher and her amazing staff....
- ...The teachers know exactly how to challenge and inspire...
- ...We love All Saints, a great school community & fantastic teaching staff....
- ...My child loves coming to school...
- ...really impressed with the organisation, effort and amount of hard work [from the school]...

My child feels safe at this school

- ...There's a level of trust that both us as parents, and our children, have for the school that gives a great deal of comfort...
- ... any problems dealt with in a professional and caring way....
- ...My child knows who to go to if she has an issue and what good behaviour is....

The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved

- ...Whenever we have attended school functions / performances, the children's behaviour has been exemplary and you can see that each child responds well to their teacher...
- ...If my child is worried about anything - she knows to tell a teacher and is confident to do that. She knows what is expected of her at school and also how other may make wrong choices one day but good choices the next....
- ...I feel the school are excellent at teaching the importance of behaviour and manners...

My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively

- ...Where certain characters are stronger than others, teachers generally let the children work it out, but whenever it has escalated or gone beyond what is acceptable, the teachers have always stepped in and taken the appropriate action....
- ...My child knows that all the teaching assistants and teachers are consistent in dealing with behaviour...
- ...My child's teacher has been very supportive and dealt with a couple of incidents promptly that happened during the school day...
- ...My child hasn't been bullied but there have been times where friendship groups have been tricky and I've needed to speak with my child's teacher. The situation has always been dealt with fairly and promptly and issues resolved. I feel I can approach the school very easily if there are any concerns I have about unkindness....

The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year

- ...The themes of the year are always communicated at the start of the year and at periodic intervals throughout the year...
- ...We have lots of parent involvement opportunities and the teachers give us progress reports termly....
- ...Extra support has been put in place efficiently and quickly...
- ..Great weekly communication...
- ..Communication between teacher and parents is excellent...

When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly

- ...Generally, all concerns that we have raised have been answered swiftly and in an engaging and positive manner...
- ...Assessment, referrals and recommendations to help with her comprehension....
- ..I have always felt totally supported and listened to...
- ..The HT is very open and approachable...
- ...I raised a minor concern about a pattern of behaviour from another child - Faultless response. Class teacher had already noticed, monitoring would continue and next steps explained should the pattern continue. As parents, we couldn't ask for more...

My child has SEND and the school gives them the support they need to succeed

- The school have been very supportive and proactive with getting my child the additional help he needs. I feel much more confident knowing they have our backs.
- Since joining All Saints extra daily support has been given to improve reading level & writing skills. The school has been outstanding in their support both educationally & emotionally.
- Teachers continue to be transparent & available for support if required.

The school has high expectations of my child

- The school has realistic views given my child's SEN
- At a suitable level for his age
- I cannot fault the quality of teaching and teachers at this school. They are exemplary and inspire us parents as well as the children.
- Not just to fulfil their academic potential, but to fulfil their personal potential and draw out their qualities and character.

My child does well at this school

- Excelling really well in all the classes she has been in
- They have additional needs so the focus for feedback tends to be surrounding this rather than what he's achieving in other areas
- My child is blossoming and is proud of her own achievements.
- I can't fault it.
- We are in the perfect school for our children & so happy that we decided to move schools.
- I'm seeing my child go from strength to strength in aspects of his learning and social abilities. His reading is just amazing and I'm always so surprised how quickly this comes along.

The school lets me know how my child is doing

- The school provides regular updates via formal and informal means
- I don't feel that a one-page sheet and a 10 minute chat really let's me know where my child's strengths and weaknesses are.
- Weekly class updates on the website- opportunities to talk to class teacher every day. Head teacher greets us every morning and is available for us to talk if we have an issue. Face to face parent meetings and also Open books days that invite parents in to see their work books.
- Their reports are always full of detail.
- When struggling with pieces in class it would be great to know so I can help at home at the time as my child worries but appreciate this isn't always possible.

My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school

- The variety of clubs is not as good as it could be despite suggesting alternatives
- The school goes out of its way to provide as many extra-curricular as possible. From our experience, the only times clubs have not really been a success is when parents haven't supported the offering and numbers have been too few.
- In terms of activities, the school excels. Some of the girls' best days/memories of the year are from school outings or activities held at the school. The teachers and PTA do an amazing job, and their commitment to the children is second-to-none.
- Could be more for year 1. lack of sports clubs, football for instance or gardening club. other outdoor activities.
- New clubs would be welcomed... art club or non sports after school club
- We access after school clubs and forest school opportunities. great emphasis on sports .
- The range of clubs and activities are outstanding for a primary school of this size.
- Loves woodpeckers!

The school supports my child's wider development

- ... subjects like music are introduced to the students so that they at least have some introduction and exposure to it at a relatively early age....
- ...Enrichment days for all school to learn about different cultures, countries etc. Mixed age groups for older ones to help younger ones. Lovely community feel!...
- ...The school offers the children many enrichments days thoroughly the year to support wider learning and mental health....
- Emotional well-being & connection to nature are vital and both of these boxes are ticked.

The school offers a good range of lunch options

- ..I think portions are small but that comes with a tight budget that the school has to manage so, is understandable.
