LOOKING AHEAD

We are already looking ahead to the new school year and we have two great initiatives to look forward to:

We have been selected to work with The British Council as part of their Global Partnership Programme in the autumn term. As part of this, we will create a partnership with a school in another part of the world. We will correspond with pupils and share work about global learning topics, such as climate change so that our pupils can understand what it is like to live in another country and how life is similar or different and how this relates to environmental issues. This links with the work the children do within science and geography and is a wonderful opportunity for our pupils.

We will also be working with the Careers Hub as part of their Small Steps, Big Dreams programme. The programme will look at ways in which to link lessons to careers. It will also provide opportunities for pupils to meet inspiring employers so they can explore different jobs and understand the skills they'll need for the future. The Careers Hub will work with us to create whole school careers events and opportunities for employers from a range of sectors to talk to the children in their classes.
